

A CORN-BELT DISTRIBUTOR FOR SEED AND FERTILIZER

The V-belt and the cone are two common distributors used on plot seeders. The V-belt has the advantage of trouble-free operation for both seed and fertilizer. However, it is bulky and difficult to load uniformly. The cone offers a compact assembly which is easy to load uniformly. Its main disadvantage is the sometimes frequent maintenance required to keep it operational. Particles of dust or foreign material build up between the cone and the base and suddenly seize the mechanism. This is particularly true for distributing fertilizer. The cone-belt distributor retains the advantages and overcomes the disadvantages of each system.
